SUBJECT: Automatic-Qualification and Earned Access Online Process.

NCAA Division II conferences eligible for automatic qualification and/or earned access (football only) for future championships are required to submit an automatic-qualification and earned access form for all seasons by **February 1, 2018**.

The NCAA currently grants automatic qualification or earned access to the following Division II championships:

Baseball

Men's and Women's Basketball

*Women's Bowling

*Men's Gymnastics

*Women's Ice Hockey

Men's and Women's Soccer

The automatic qualification application forms may be accessed via the NCAA Championships Bid and Profile System.

1. Go to <http://championships.ncaa.org/>.
2. Enter your login credentials for the portal. If you have not yet created an account for this system previously, please click on the Request Account link to create your username and password.
3. Once logged on, click on the tab entitled "AQ Forms." This will direct you to your conference's automatic qualification home page.

Please complete the necessary information for all your sports, then fill out the final confirmation and contact section. Submission of this final section will complete the process for all sports. You are not required to complete the form at one time; you may save at any point and continue later. A progress bar, as well as checkmarks next to completed sports, will assist you in keeping track of where you are in the process. You may access and, if necessary, edit the form at any time before the due date. A \$500 fine will be assessed to any conferences that fail to submit the automatic qualification form by the established deadline.

All automatic-qualification and earned access data is retained at the national office. Therefore, for previously submitted applications, most questions will populate with last year's responses. Please confirm information copied from a previous year, and make adjustments as necessary.

Also attached for planning purposes is a summary of selection dates and automatic qualifier notification due dates for 2018-19. Conference offices, or their designees, should notify the NCAA of their automatic qualifier by sport via the following link: <https://www.planningpoint.net/Events/CHAMPSAQ>. Specific information regarding each championship's reporting timeline can be found within the respective pre-championships manual for that sport.
