

All Star Game – Tryouts

NCAA certification legislation prohibits a certified league involving currently enrolled Division I student-athletes from including any kind of all-star competitions in conjunction with the league.

Additionally, Division I student-athletes are restricted to participating on only one team in only one league per summer. Therefore, Division I student-athletes are prohibited from participating in any kind of organized tryout for placement in a league that involves team competition.

Postseason play-offs or tournaments are permitted, provided that:

1. the athlete competes on the same team they have played with throughout the league;
2. the play-off/tournament only involves intraleague competition; and
3. play-offs or tournaments are completed by August 31.

If a try-out or all-star game occurs in conjunction with an NCAA-certified league, current or future certification of the league may be affected.
