


Clarifications and Interpretations

Question: For the smallbore rifle, may stock extensions be added to the bottom of the fore-end of the stock for kneeling and/or prone positions?

Discussion/Answer: Yes, with the below limitations.



For smallbore rifles, the palm block or stock extension must not exceed 200 mm below the bore line.

7.4.5.2 Palm Rests

A palm rest is any removeable attachment or extension below the fore-end that aids the support of the rifle by the forward hand. Such extensions must not extend more than 200 mm below the centerline of the barrel.
