

Awards

Many operators provide awards during events/leagues (e.g., to the team that wins a tournament, to the best offensive or defensive player, three-point or slam-dunk contests, etc.). A participant may receive an award, as long as the following conditions are met:

- The cost of the award IS included in and does not exceed the cost of the participant's entry fee;
- The award being given is NOT cash, or the equivalent thereof; and
- Awards are NOT donated.

If participants do not directly pay an entry fee, no awards may be provided.

Example: If a team sponsor pays the event entry fee for the team; the event operator could give a championship trophy to the team, but could not provide awards to the athletes because the athletes did not play to participate in the event.

A t-shirt may be provided as an award in addition to the event t-shirt provided to all participants in the event, but the award t-shirt CANNOT be donated.
