

2018 NCAA Regional Rules Seminars Session Type Descriptions



FOUNDATIONAL

Presenter will share entry-level content. These sessions may include a basic overview of legislation, basic case studies, straightforward application of legislation and associated interpretations, and/or an introduction to navigating the academic and membership affairs processes.



FOUNDATIONAL PLUS

These sessions may include an intermediate-level overview of specific legislation and associated interpretations, case studies, best practices for interpreting and applying the legislation and associated interpretations, and/or a review of navigating the academic and membership affairs processes. Session attendees should have a base-level understanding of fundamental legislation and processes.



ADVANCED

Presenter will share advanced-level content. These sessions may include a narrow review of specific legislation and associated interpretations (e.g., existence of uncertainty, confusion and high volume of questions and/or misapplication), complex case studies, best practices for interpreting and applying the legislation, and associated interpretations and/or a specific review of navigating the academic and membership affairs processes.



DIALOGUE

A discussion will be facilitated by staff and attendee participation is encouraged.



LIMITED SEATING

A limited seating session is one in which attendees who registered for sessions with limited space (e.g., Division I Legislative Process/Drafting 101) will have priority seating based on the registration list.
