**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

- 1. Exempted events.** The Men's Golf Committee supported a waiver to permit student-athletes to participate in the 2017 Collegiate All-American outside of their declared 144-day playing season (but not the limit of two student-athletes per institution), on the condition that the Collegiate All-American work to propose a legislative change for future events
- 2. Course access during the regular season at the championships finals site.** The committee modified its stance from the summer meeting and will maintain the course access policy, as currently written, for the future. However, the committee will continue to discuss with the Division I Women's Golf Committee and the membership whether the current policy should be amended to allow for open access throughout the season for all teams.
- 3. Substitution for postseason.** The committee discussed the recent approval of allowing substitutions for NCAA postseason play and determined that the sixth player must be identified to the games committee prior to using the practice facilities and will be permitted to practice in the practice round at both the regionals and finals.
